Situated in the north in the valley of the Chui river, the only large city of Kyrgyz Republic. Bishkek enjoys a good climate during both the summer and winter seasons. ## For Indian Students

### MCI Regulations for Recognition of Foreign Medical Degrees

Prior to the year 2002, Indian students were required to join only those medical colleges abroad which were listed by the Medical Council of India in their schedules. However, it was not feasible and possible for the Medical Council of India to visit individual colleges in different countries to inspect and recognize colleges. Therefore, in the year 2001, the Indian parliament passed a bill to amend the Indian Medical Council Act 1956, which later became an Act and was subsequently notified in the Indian Gazette. According to the new amendments: Eligibility Certificate Regulations, 2002 and Screening test regulations, 2002. (Published in Part III, Section 4 of the Gazette of India Extraordinary issue dated the 18th February, 2002) Medical Council of India, Notification, New Delhi dated the 13th February, 2002 No.MCI-203/02/2001-Regn'; Indian students are free to go to any medical colleges in any foreign country but college is must be enlisted in WHO.

From the year 2002, the former list of recognized medical colleges ceased to exist. Therefore, the screening examination is now required if an Indian student completes his medical course from USA, UK, Australia or any where in world. The Indian Student who is willing to enter into Asian Medical Institute must Obtain MCI eligibility certificate from the Medical council of India, New Delhi. And after completion of the course the student who wants to get registration number from MCI have to appear for the Screening test conducted by the National Board of Examinations, New Delhi.

**Please note that the previous list of 'Recognized colleges from erstwhile USSR is not valid now'.**

Any Indian student who has obtained a minimum 50% (General candidates) and 40% (Reserved candidates) in their Physics, Chemistry and Biology (PCB) in the higher secondary examination (i.e. 12th standard final examination) are eligible to get the Eligibility Certificate.

### Student Life

More than 800 Indian students in which nearly 200 girls are studying Graduation Courses at the faculty of General Medicine in Bishkek. The Indian students can work in USA, UK, Australia, Canada, New Zealand and other countries after completing course from AMI. They can also work as Govt., private doctors in India and Senior consultants in corporate hospitals in India. AMI arranges free preparatory class for screening test for MCI from 4th year.

AMI administration has always encouraged and promoted secularism amongst its students. This has been the main reason for communal harmony and peace among fellow Indian students studying at AMI. In order to make students' life more interesting there are all the conditions in the institute to conduct cultural measure. For students of the institute there are all the conditions for leisure, namely sport halls, gym, swimming pool & etc. institute organize different festivals, tours, games and encourage students to take part in different study and sport competition. For students' habitation there are such conditions as hostel and separate comfortable apartments with all the conditions.

Foreign students are trained on the contract basis in concurrence with the law of Kyrgyz republic "About the legal status of Foreigners." Foreign citizens of the Kyrgyz origin enjoy the equal rights as Kyrgyz citizens. All institute entrants enjoy the equal rights independently sex, racial & national belonging, social and property status, ideology, religion, place of residence and other circumstances.

Every year many national and religious festivals celebrate with pomp and joy. National festivals included the Republic Day while religious festivals celebrated from the Indian sub continent are Diwali, Holi, Sankranti, Ifar Party in the holy month of Ramadan, Eid, etc.



## Accommodation

There is separate hostel for Indian students. The hostel atmosphere is clam, quite and conducive for studies. The security and comforts of the students always remains our prime objective.

The hostel room is furnished with beds, side tables, chairs, one large sized study table, and Pillows, Bed Sheets, Mattresses, Quilts and Blankets. Each room has a large window for easy ventilation. Every room has an automated heating device that runs 24x7 during the winter season to maintain optimum temperature in the hostel rooms. Each hostel floor has a set of toilets and bathrooms that have a regular 24x7 cold and hot water supply. A laundry and a press service operate in the Hostel for the benefit of the students residing in the hostel. Workers have been appointed to collect dirty clothes from the students, wash them and return back after ironing. This has saved the precious time of the students that they can utilize for studies. Additional workers have been appointed to maintain cleanliness and hygiene in the Hostel. Rooms, Toilets and Bathrooms are cleaned and wiped on a daily basis. Bed sheets, Pillow Covers and Quilts are changed weekly twice. Separate Hostel has been allotted to the female students.



### Food

Food is the most important and the basic necessity of life. The university's hostel has a canteen where Indian cooks work and run by Indian representative. In the building of the hostel there is the student canteen with a snack bar. Students have opportunities to enjoy the traditional Indian cuisine. The Indian mess has a variety of menu that includes chapatti, rice, sweets etc. The Mess serves Vegetarian and Non Vegetarian dishes. Special preparations can be ordered or requested by students to the mess administration to celebrate birthdays, festivals and parties etc.

Note: - Facility of separate Kitchen for the students interested in cooking for own self is also provided with in the hostel.



## Fees Structure:-

Tuition Fee : USD 1800 Per year

Hotel Fee : USD 200 Per year

The administration of Asian Medical Institute (AMI) informs that student's expenditure for the 1st years Doctor of Medicine (M.D) English medium course will approximately be 3400 USD including Tuition, Hostel, Admission, Visa extension, Documents translation, Medical certificate and others fee. This fee should be paid within 3 days of arrival in Kyrgyz Republic.

Apart from the above fees students have to pay for their Air-ticket, Invitation fee, Visa fee, Air-port pick up charge, Registration, consultancy fee, liaisoning fee and other travel expenses in India.

## Admission

This is English Medium program. Student should have passed intermediate level or 10+2 through science stream with biology/pre-medical subjects having 50% marks in aggregate or 50% in PCB/PCBE.

There is no provision for direct admission in AMI. Student can contact our admission centers or liaison persons from India & Nepal on behalf of AMI. After getting the provisional admission letter, admission will be confirm.

For any kind of dispute the decision will totally depend upon the institute.
